REGULAR MEETING DECEMBER 10, 2012

The twelfth regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg, Sussex County, New Jersey was held in the Council Chambers of the Borough Hall on December 10, 2012.

Mayor Ciasullo called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Upon roll call, the following council members appeared and answered the call: Amodeo Andrews, Hann, Ingerto, McGuire, Opilla.

Jennifer Smith, from the Alternative Press inquired about an outdoor furnace. There being no further business from the public, Councilman Andrews moved, Councilman McGuire seconded motion to close the public hearing. Yeas: Amodeo, Andrews, Hann, Ingerto, McGuire, Opilla.

Councilman Andrews moved, Councilman McGuire seconded motion to adopt said ordinance. Yeas: Amodeo, Andrews, Hann, Ingerto, McGuire, Opilla.

Councilman Hann moved, Councilman Ingerto seconded motion to open the public session of the meeting. Yeas: Amodeo, Andrews, Hann, Ingerto, McGuire, Opilla.

Jennifer Smith, from the Alternative Press asked if anyone in town has an outside furnace. Mayor informed her that no one has an outside furnace. Ms. Smith also asked about the Flag being at half mask. She was informed that it was for Pearl Harbor Day and will be put back up. Ms. Smith asked who makes the decisions on what type of signs are used for businesses with regard to the Main Street Streetscape. She was informed that the Borough has ordinances regarding signs for businesses. Jean Castimore, President of the Historical Society inquired about money from their account being rolled over for 2013 in the budget. Councilman Hann said they couldn't roll over the money, but will match what the Historical Society had in for 2012 and add an additional \$200.

NEW BUSINESS

Councilman Ingerto informed Mayor and Council about the Christmas lights for the tree. The Department of Public Works never checked the lights so at the time of the tree lighting only half of the lights went on. Also because the tree has gotten so big that it was hard to reach the top portion of the tree. The lights were fixed and should be able to use for another two years. It was suggested to cut down the tree and plant another one in its place. The Clerk informed Mayor and Council about an e-mail received from the State Registrar's office regarding a disaster recovery plan for vital records.

OLD BUSINESS

Councilman Opilla spoke about getting all the new meters installed. There are still 350 meters to install and is working on getting a plan in place to have them all installed by the summer. Councilman Opilla would like to put a start date and a end date on the project. Councilman McGuire mentioned that Ann Peters just finished up and passed another class for Taxes. Her next class will start in January.

Mayor spoke briefly about the concerns that the Board of Health has with the Animal Control Officer. Mayor Ciasullo said that he has spoken to the Administrator in Wantage and that he in turn has spoken to the Animal Control Officer. It was decided that in the future whenever there is a question or concern the Board of Health secretary can contact the Animal Control Officer at the time of the incident. The Mayor also mentioned that there are three men doing four towns. Councilman Andrews spoke about getting a generator and going out to bid. A list will be put together of what will need to be covered and an option B put in for the Fire Department hook up. Mayor spoke about a police hire. The Mayor explained the procedure and how the time frame works with the applicants list. The Borough can get a 60 day extension for the list or if we can't do it in that time frame they can cancel the present list and call for a new list closer to an anticipated appointment date. Council spoke about the possibility of getting someone into the Academy for February. Clerk will inquire about a longer extension period. Further discussion will be forth coming.

Council discussed the update on getting a light for the back lot. Will need to get a licensed electrician to install the light. Mayor mentioned that the Christmas party went well. Council was happy with the caterer and menu. Clerk will keep information on hand for next year.

Councilman Hann mentioned briefly about the Gingerbread Cookie contest that was held on December 9th at the Firehouse. It was for ages 18 and over and about 50 people attended. Council asked the attorney about the codification of the ordinances. Attorney will return them to the Clerk. Councilman Ingerto informed Mayor and Council that the drug alliance will be able to use the First Aid Squad building for the Teen Canteen. The Drug Alliance hopes to start in January. The Drug Alliance is also looking for a shed to be able to store equipment for the group. It was also mentioned that they need a coordinator for the Ogdensburg Alliance.

Councilman Hann moved, Councilman McGuire seconded motion for review and approval of vouchers. Yeas: Amodeo, Andrews, Hann, Ingerto, Opilla.
