## BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG COUNTY OF SUSSEX ORDINANCE 10-2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 6, "PARKS AND RECREATIONAL AREAS," SECTION 6-1.2(C), "REGULATION OF SWIMMING AREAS" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF OGDENSBURG

WHEREAS, the Borough of Ogdensburg ("Borough") desires to amend and supplement Chapter 6 entitled "Parks and Recreational Areas" of the Code of the Borough ("Code") to permit properly licensed and leashed dogs at the Heater's Pond swimming area.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,**by the Borough Council of the Borough of Ogdensburg, County of Sussex and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 6of the Borough Code entitled "Parks and Recreational Areas" is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

**SECTION 1.**Section 6-1.2(c) entitled "Regulation for Swimming Areas" of the Code is hereby replaced in its entirety as follows:

- 6-1.2 Regulations for Swimming Areas.
  - c. No pets or animals shall be allowed in the designated swim area, Swim Team area or beach area unless they are animals trained to assist the disabled, or as otherwise provided for herein. Dogs are permitted in the Heater's Pond swimming and beach areas only during non-activity hours. Accordingly, dogs shall not be permitted in the Heater's Pond swimming and beach areasbetween 12:00 noon and 6:00 p.m. during the summer season, or during any period of time said areas are being used for Swim Team meets and practice. All dogs must be properly licensed and kept under the control of individual at least 18 years of age. Pet owners and keepers are responsible for the actions and behavior of their dogs and are strictly liable for any incidents that occur in the permitted area. All pet owners and keepers are required to immediately and properly dispose their pet's solid waste deposited within the permitted area by appropriate sanitary means including, but not limited to plastic bags.

**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or a portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective after second reading and publication as required by law.
